SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

This week, on Thursday, 18th May, we celebrate **The Ascension of the Lord**. **This is a Holyday of Obligation.** Mass will be celebrated at 9.15 am and 7.30 pm

The next day, 19th May, is the feast day of **St Dunstan** who was born at Glastonbury in 909. He was Abbot of Glastonbury but later exiled to Belgium. On his return, he became Bishop of Worcester and London, then Archbishop of Canterbury. We have a stained-glass window of St. Dunstan in our church.

On 20th May, it is the feast day of **St Bernardine of Siena**, born in 1380, described as the "greatest preacher of his time" he attracted crowds of 30,000. Known for his devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus, he developed a symbol – *IHS* – the first three letters of the name of Jesus in Greek, in Gothic letters on a blazing sun. This symbol is seen in several places in our church especially in the wooden frame of the painting of The Divine Mercy.
