# **WEEK 10 IN ORDINARY TIME**

Today is the feast of **Corpus Christi** – the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. It proclaims the truth of the transubstantiation of bread and wine into the actual body blood soul and divinity of Christ during the Mass.

Tuesday, 13<sup>th</sup> June, marks the feast day of **St Anthony of Padua**. He was born in Lisbon in 1193. Renowned as a preacher, he travelled around Africa, Italy and France and is the patron saint of lost items, the poor and travellers.

Two further feast days are also celebrated this week – the **Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus** on Friday and the **Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary** on Saturday.
