TWENTY THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

There are two feast days for the Blessed Virgin this week:

On Tuesday, 12th September, we celebrate the **Most Holy Name of Mary** and on Friday, 15th September, we celebrate Mary's title of **Our Lady of Sorrows**. It focuses on her intense suffering and grief during the passion and death of Our Lord.

On Thursday, 14th September, it is the Feast of **The Exaltation of the Cross** celebrating the Cross as the instrument of our salvation.
