#### **TWENTY FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

On Thursday, 21<sup>st</sup> September, we remember the Apostle, **St Matthew**, who collected taxes for the Romans. Jesus chose him as one of the founders of the church, but St Matthew was honest enough to admit he was one sinners Jesus came to call.

On Saturday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September, it is the feast day of **Padre Pio** who was born in Italy in 1887. St Pio became a Capuchin Friar and for 50 years was a much sought after spiritual advisor whose life was devoted to the Eucharist and prayer. At his canonisation in 2002 Pope St John Paul II said: "*his life and mission testify that difficulties and sorrows, if accepted with love, transform themselves into a privileged journey of holiness*".
