THIRTY FOURTH WEEK IN ORDINARY TIME

Today is The Solemnity of **Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe**, a feast day which was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI. Celebrating the true kingship of Christ, it marks the last Sunday in the liturgical year.

Thursday, 30th November, is the feast day of the Apostle, **St Andrew**, the patron saint of Scotland. He was the brother of St Peter and preached the Good News in Greece and Turkey. On Saturday, we remember **Blessed Rafal Chylinski** who was born near Buk in the Poznan region of Poland in 1694. He was well known for his simple and candid sermons and for his generosity. He spent the last 13 years of his life ministering to flood and epidemic victims in Warsaw.


