#### FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Today, Sunday, is the feast day of St Francis Xavier. He was ordained a priest in Venice before moving to Lisbon, Portugal, then on to the East Indies. He landed at Goa on the West Coast of India where he lived for 10 years. Although he went on to live and bring the Good News in Malaysia and Japan, his body is buried in the Church of Good Jesus in Goa. His life was one of countless hours spent ministering to the sick and the poor, particularly to lepers, but he was always filled with joy.

On Wednesday, 6th December, children all over Europe will be putting their shoes and stockings outside their bedroom doors for a visit from St Nicholas, Bishop of Myra in Asia Minor. In English speaking countries, he became Santa Claus. He is remembered for tossing three bags of gold through the window of a poor man so that his three daughters could be married with a dowry. His legendary chary finds him called 'Good St Nick' and we remember him by giving gifts at Christmas.

On Friday, 8th December, we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
