This bulletin is for this week commencing 24th December and the following Sunday 31st December.

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

We celebrate the Feast of the Nativity on Monday, 25th December.

The next day, Tuesday 26th December, we celebrate St Stephen, deacon and the first martyr. He was one of the seven deacons appointed by the Apostles to distribute alms to the faithful. He is the patron saint of altar servers.

On Wednesday, 27th December, it is the feast day of St John, disciple, and witness to special events. He ended his days at Ephesus where he cared for Our Lady whom he took as his adopted mother.

We pray for The Holy Innocents on Thursday, 28th December. Baby boys aged two and under were ordered to be massacred by Herod in and around Bethlehem in order to kill Jesus. An angel appeared to Joseph to warn him to take Mary and the baby to safety In Egypt.

FEAST OF THE HOLY FAMILY (Sunday 31st December) The Feast of the Holy Family celebrates the human family unit, as well as the ultimate family unit: Jesus, Mary, and Joseph.

The devotion to the Holy Family was born in Bethlehem along with baby Jesus. The shepherds went to adore the Child, and at the same time, they gave honour to His family. Later, in a similar way, the three wise men came from the East to adore and give honour to the newborn King with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh that would be safeguarded by His family.

The Feast of the Holy Family is not just about the Holy Family, but about our own families too. The main purpose of the Feast is to present the Holy Family as the model for all Christian families, and for domestic life in general. Our family life becomes sanctified when we live the life of the Church within our homes. This is called the "domestic church." St. John Chrysostom urged all Christians to make each home a "family church," and in doing so, this sanctifies the family unit. Just how does one live out the Church in the family? The best way is by making Christ the centre of family and individual life. Ways to do this include reading scripture regularly, praying daily, attending Mass at least on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, imitating the actions of the Holy Family, going to confession frequently, all done together as a family unit.


