#### FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Tomorrow, Monday, is the feast day of **St Catherine of Siena** in Italy. She was the youngest of more than 20 children of a Sienese dyer who devoted her time to prayer and helping the sick. For the last five years of her life, she worked for the return of the papacy from Avignon in France to Rome. She is a Doctor of the Church and Patron Saint of Europe.

On Wednesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, we celebrate the second feast day for St Joseph. Pope Pius XII instituted the feast of **St Joseph the Worker** in response to the May Day celebrations for workers sponsored by Communists.

The 40 canonised **English Martyrs** are remembered on Saturday. They joined the 85 beatified martyrs who died for the Catholic faith in England for this feast day with hundreds of others from the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> centuries.

On Thursday May 9<sup>th</sup> it is Ascension Day.

It is a Holy Day of Obligation and Masses will be at 9.15am and 7.30pm.

Before the 9.15am Mass there will be the May procession by the school children.
