ST PATRICKS AND ST JOSEPHS

Parishioners from each community have access to the services and care from all the ministers in either location. The activities of each parish will be open to all and duplicated programmes will be integrated into one – example: Altar Servers society, Parish Council, Sacramental programmes, fundraising, Safeguarding and Health & Safety, Social activities etc.

This new evolution will enrich the lives of both communities and bring new talent and initiative into all our lives. Please pray for the success of the new direction in parish life for St Patrick's and St Joseph's.
