TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Tuesday, 23rd September is the feast day of St Pius of Pietrelcina, better known as Padre Pio. For 50 years he was a much sought after spiritual adviser who devoted his life to the Eucharist and prayer. He died in 1968.

The next day, Wednesday, is the Feast of Our Lady of Walsingham. In 1934, the Slipper Chapel was consecrated as the National Catholic Shrine to Our Lady.
